2/21.12.2012 The present bail application is filed under Sections 439 and 440 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking bail in connection with Nawadih P. S. Case No. 90 of 2012 corresponding to G. R. No. 1085 of 2012 for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379 of the Indian Penal Code which is now pending in the Court of learned A. C.J.M. Bermo at Tenughat.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

Perused the F.I.R. and other papers annexed to the application.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the the investigation is substantially over. The injury certificate clearly indicates that the injury is simple in nature.

Having regard to the nature of accusation and gravity of the offence, the petitioner, Paras Ansari @ Parsuddin @ Parsuddin Ansari is directed to be enlarged on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of A. C.J.M. Bermo at Tenughat in connection with Nawadih P. S. Case No. 90 of 2012 corresponding to G. R. No. 1085 of 2012 subject to the following conditions:-

1. that applicant shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under this chapter,
2. that applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected,
3. that applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence,
4. that applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court, and
5. that applicant shall mark his presence before the concerned police station in any day of the first week of every month till the commencement of trial.
