ORDER (30-3-2012)

- 1. By this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure the applicant has challenged legality and propriety of the order dated 20.1.2009 passed by the Second Additional Sessions Judge (F.T.C.), Surajpur, in Criminal Revision No.154/2008 and the order dated 26.7.2008 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Surajpur, in Criminal Complaint Case No.348/2008, whereby the trial Court has taken cognizance for the offence punishable under Section 15 of the Environment Protection Act, 1986 against the petitioner.
- 2. I have heard learned counsel for the parties, perused the order impugned, copy of the complaint, order of the trial Court and other documents filed on behalf of the petitioner.
- At this stage, it would not be proper to investigate or inquire into the matter. The present applicant is at liberty to raise all the grounds before the trial Court in terms of Section 245(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 4. With the aforesaid observation, the petition stands disposed of.
