**ORDER**

(30-3-2012)

1. By this petition under Section 482 of the CrPC, the petitioner has challenged legality and propriety of the order dated 5-8-2011 passed by the Special Judge under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Raipur, in Criminal Revision No.119/2011, affirming the order dated 4-5-2011 passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Raipur in Criminal Case No.255/2011.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that respondent No.1 herein has frankly admitted on 10-2-2012 that he is admitting the documents filed on behalf of the petitioner herein and is having no objection if the petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is allowed.
3. In these circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction that respondent No.1 herein/complainant shall withdraw the complaint against the petitioner herein before the trial Court by filing appropriate petition within fifteen days from today.
