<u>ORDER</u> (30-3-2012)

- 1. By this petition under Section 482 of the CrPC, the petitioner has challenged legality and propriety of the order dated 5-8-2011 passed by the Special Judge under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Raipur, in Criminal Revision No.119/2011, affirming the order dated 4-5-2011 passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Raipur in Criminal Case No.255/2011.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that respondent No.1 herein has frankly admitted on 10-2-2012 that he is admitting the documents filed on behalf of the petitioner herein and is having no objection if the petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is allowed.
- In these circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction that respondent No.1 herein/complainant shall withdraw the complaint against the petitioner herein before the trial Court by filing appropriate petition within fifteen days from today.
- 4. Consequently, I.A.No.1 also stands disposed of.
