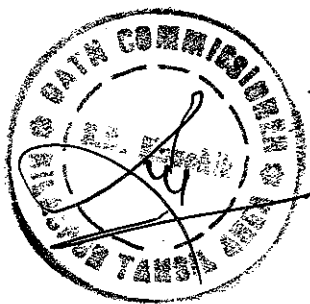

**ORAL ORDER
(27/12/2012)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been appointed as Assistant Grade III in the office of Collector (Tribal Development) District North Bastar, Kanker on 03/11/2012 pursuant to which she has joined on the post and has thereafter approached the respondent No. 3 for providing required form for submission of application for verification of her caste status in terms of the judgment rendered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the matter of *Kumari Madhuri Patil and another Vs. Additional Commissioner, Tribal Development and others* reported in (1994) 6 SCC 241. He would submit that in the event her caste status is not verified within two months her services may be terminated and she shall suffer irreparable loss.

(2) Considering the entire fact situation of the case it is directed that if the petitioner approaches the respondent No. 3 within one week from today the required application form shall be supplied and the petitioner shall submit a duly filled in application form within a week thereafter for verification of her caste status and thereafter the concerned authority shall scrutinize/verify her caste status within a period of 1½ months thereafter. It is made clear that the verification shall be done strictly in accordance with law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of *Kumari Madhuri Patil* (supra).

(3) The Caste Scrutiny Committee shall decide the issue within an outer limit of two months and during this period the petitioner's services shall not be discontinued on the ground that she has failed to submit duly verified caste status certificate.
