CAV JUDGMENT

By way of this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973,

the petitioner, an IPS officer, seeks to challenge the legality, validity and propriety of the order dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011 passed by the Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department, Government of Gujarat, granting sanction under Section 197 of the Code to prosecute the petitioner in connection with Criminal Case No.93 of 2002 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Anand.

I need not adjudicate this petition for the simple reason that this Court, vide order dated 11.5.2012 passed in Special Criminal Application No.1467 of 2011, has quashed the order of process issued by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Anand, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2011 in Court Inquiry No.93 of 2002.

Since the very prosecution has been quashed, the issue of legality, validity and propriety of sanction under Section 197 of the Code pales into insignificance. I may only clarify that otherwise I have not gone into the merits of this issue.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
