**PER COURT :**

1. The petitioner challenges the cancellation of its College as center for Higher Secondary Examination at Jalkot.

2. Shri. More, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that since in the

identical matters, this Court has granted interim relief, the petitioner herein is also entitled for the same.

3. No doubt, in some matters by way of interim relief centers are continued. However, in the said matters the students of the school are from remote rural areas and they would have been required to travel distance of 10 to 12 k.m. from the place of their residence and would have been required to waste their valuable hours in "to and fro journey" for attending the center. Such is not the case here. In the present case, the center, which is now granted, is also at Jalkot itself. Therefore, there is no similarity in the facts of the present case to grant interim relief. As such, the prayer for interim relief deserves to be rejected.

4. No case is made out for interference. Therefore, petition is rejected.
