1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicants. At the request of the learned counsel for the applicants, matter is taken on board at 3 p.m.

2. The learned counsel for the applicants states that pursuant to the order dt.29.2.2012 passed by this court (Coram: Mrs.Mridula Bhatkar, J.), they require some time to deposit the amount of interest from the date of claim application @ 7.5% p.a.

Therefore, they seek extension of time to deposit the same.

3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicants and the averments made in Civil Application, I am satisfied that the applicants have made out a case for allowing this Civil Application. Hence, Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a) which reads thus:

“(a) The time to deposit the amount of interest from the date of claim Application @ 7.5% p.a. In the Tribunal as per the order dated 29/02/2012 may be extended for further period of 12 weeks.”

4. Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
