## <u>P.C.</u>:

The present anticipatory bail application seeks transit anticipatory bail in respect of an offence which is registered in Goa. The applicant is a Portuguese citizen who is otherwise resident of Goa, who has learnt from her husband that C.R.No.41 of 2012 has been filed by CID, EOW, Punji at Goa police station, Goa.

- 2 Dr. Pawaskar, Counsel for the applicant mentions the matter for urgent relief, I find that State of Maharashtra has not been made a party and also that the nature and particulars of the alleged offence has not been set out in the transit anticipatory bail application. When the aforesaid facts were pointed out to Dr. Pawaskar, he sought to withdraw the anticipatory bail application.
