1 Learned Counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to have the petition numbered within two weeks.

2 The limited grievance made in this petition is that even though a statutory Appeal has been filed by the Petitioner, which is still pending before the Appellate Authority, no interim order has been passed by the Appellate Authority on the

stay Application and protection available to the Petitioner given by the First Authority continued up to 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2012.

2           In the circumstances, learned A.G.P. states across the bar that the Appeal will be decided within eight weeks from today by the Appellate Authority. The assurance is accepted. Till the Appeal is decided, the interim protection accorded to the Petitioner shall continue. The protection will continue for a further period of two weeks from the date of proposed order to be passed by the Appellate Authority is communicated to the Petitioner to enable the Petitioner to take up the matter before appropriate forum, if the decision of the Appellate Authority is adverse to the Petitioner.
