## ORDER

Learned Addl. Government Advocate submits that in identical matters W.P.Nos.66250-254/2012, the learned Single Judge by Order dated 02.04.2012 following the earlier decision of this Court set-aside the demand and recovery of 10% of the compensation as income tax.

2. In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Endorsement dated nil, Annexure-C of the Special Land Acquisition Officer in so far as it relates to deduction of income tax of Rs.83,067/- representing 10% of the compensation amount is quashed. Respondent is directed to make over that payment to the petitioner forthwith.
