Petitioner is before this court seeking to quash the order dated 5.4.2007 - annexure C by the Karnataka State Transport Appellate Tribunal and the order of the respondent dated 3.8.1995 - annexure A and for such other orders.

It is stated, petitioner failed to replace the vehicle on time. The difficulty expressed by him is, he intended to introduce new motor vehicle and in that process, there is delay and he also approached the Authority who has rejected his prayer and thereafter, the appellate authority has also rejected the same.
