## ORDER

The petitioner is an accused in Crime No.242/12 of Ettumanoor Police Station for offences under Sections 366(A) and 376 read with 34 IPC. He was arrested on 25.2.2012. Ever since he is in judicial custody. His application for bail was dismissed by the trial court as well as by the Sessions Court. An earlier petition was dismissed by this Court by order dated 4.4.2012.

2. Today, when the petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Public Prosecutor would submit that taking into account the period of incarceration already undergone, bail may be granted to the petitioner on conditions.

In the result, this petition is allowed. There will be an order to release the petitioner on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.30,000/- (thirty thousand) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Ettumanoor on the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioner shall report before the Investigating Officer at 10 a.m on every Friday for two months.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
  - (iii) The petitioner shall surrender his passport.
