JUDGMENT

The petitioner, a stage carriage operator conducting services on the route Chettuva-Thrissur-Valappad Beah-Pullazhy on the strength of the regular permit valid till 28.10.2014, has filed this Writ Petition complaining that an application for replacement of vehicle submitted by him has not been considered so far. The petitioner was conducting services with vehicle bearing Registration No.KL-8 J 7500. It was a specific condition of the permit that the vehicle should be replaced before 30.05.2012. In order to comply with the said condition, the petitioner submitted an application for permission to replace his vehicle with another vehicle bearing Reg.No.KL-8 AL 8000. Though the application was submitted on 26.04.2012, he complains that no orders have been passed thereon till date.

2. The learned Government Pleader on instructions submits that there were complaints that the petitioner had replaced the engine of his vehicle with another engine and therefore, enquiry into the said complaint took up some time.
