J U D G M E N T

The petitioner, a permanent driver of the 1st respondent Corporation, met with a motor vehicle accident on 24.05.2010. He sustained serious injuries and his right leg was amputated above the knee. Ext.P1 are his treatment records. According to the petitioner, he is entitled to special disability leave for the period of his treatment. Though he has submitted Ext.P2 application seeking such leave, he complains that no orders have been passed thereon till date.

2. I have heard Advocate Babu Joseph Kuruvathazha, who appears for the respondents also.

3. Since Ext.P2 is pending consideration of the 1st respondent, it is only appropriate that the said authority considers the claim of the petitioner and passes final orders thereon, expeditiously.

This Writ Petition is therefore disposed of directing the 1st respondent to consider Ext.P2 application submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law and to pass appropriate orders

thereon, as expeditiously as possible and at any rate within a period of one month of the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
