## **CRIMINAL PETITION No.4212 OF 2012**

## **ORDER:**

The Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/A-1 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.965 of 2010 on the file of the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad.

- 2. Petitioner herein is the husband of respondent No.2/de facto complainant. Respondent No.2 lodged a private complaint against the petitioner and others before the Court below and the same is forwarded for investigation to police who registered it as Crime No.45 of 2010 of Kanchanbagh Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 506, 323 & 406 I.P.C. and filed charge sheet, and the same was numbered as C.C.No.965 of 2010.
- 3. Petitioner and respondent No.2 are present today in Court hall. They are identified by their respective counsel. Respondent No.2 produced copy of her Aadhaar Card in proof of her identity. She stated that she voluntarily entered into compromise with the petitioner at the intervention of elders and well wishers and settled the matter amicably out of Court; that she entered into a matrimonial settlement deed, dated 25.04.2012; that the petitioner pronounced divorce to her on 22.02.2010 and executed a divorce declaration on 20.03.2010; that she received her entire Jahez articles, gold ornaments and cash of Rs.80,000/- and that she is not interested in prosecuting further proceedings. As per the compromise, the *de facto* complainant undertook not to prosecute case against the petitioner. In view of the fact that the offences alleged are compoundable, there is no impediment to quash the proceedings.
- 4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed quashing the

proceedings in C.C.No.965 of 2010 on the file of the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad.

 Criminal Miscellaneous Petitions, if any pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand dismissed.
