**CONTEMPT CASE No. 779 of 2008**

**Dated: 30-3-2012**

**Judgment:**

The contempt case is filed alleging violation of the order of this Court in the writ petition. This Court directed deposit of the entire compensation due and payable in accordance with the order of the Court of the learned Senior Civil Judge, Mahabubnagar dated 16-5-2002 in O.P.Nos. 68 of 1987 and 3 of 1988, to the credit of E.P.Nos. 1 and 3 of 2003.

Though belatedly this order has been complied with is the assertion made on behalf of the respondents by the learned Government Pleader for Land Acquisition. On behalf of the contempt petitioner it is stated that though a substantial amount was deposited, but there is still a dispute as to the amount liable to be paid by the State and the petitioner would pursue for recovery of the balance amount due from the respondents in the E.Ps. which are pending.

In the light of the submission above, the contempt case is dismissed with liberty granted to the contempt petitioners/writ petitioners to pursue appropriate remedies in the execution petitions pending. The Rule is accordingly discharged.
