THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE B.SESHASAYANA REDDY CRL.P.No.932 of 2012

ORDER

The petitioner is the accused in Crl.No.688 of 2011 of Uppal Police Station, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 306 IPC.

The accusation levelled against the petitioner is that he harassed his wife Bora Naga Laxmi on the ground that she has extra marital relationship with her brother-in-law. The said Bora Naga Laxmi being not able to bear the harassment committed suicide on 15-12-2011.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner treated his wife Bora Naga Laxmi with love and affection and indeed he took her to various hospitals for treatment as she is not in a position to get pregnancy. Learned counsel refers to the medical reports of Bora Naga Laxmi, copies of which finds place from page Nos.11 to 17 of the material papers, in support of his submission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the

application on the ground that investigation is pending.

As can be seen from the remand report dated

17-12-2011, the petitioner was a widower by the time he

married Bora Naga Laxmi. His first wife also died in the

suspicious circumstances. The material witnesses

examined during the course of investigation stated that

the petitioner harassed Bora Naga Laxmi on the ground of

her having questionable relationship with K.Laxma

Reddy. Investigation is stated to be pending.

In that view of the matter, I am not inclined to grant

bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the criminal petition is dismissed.
