**The Court made the following:**

**Order:**

The grievance of the petitioner- firm, which filed its tender for outsourcing non-teaching and other staff to the respondent- University in pursuance of tender notice, dated 23-02-2012, is that even though the tenders were opened on 09-03-2012, no decision thereon has been taken so far. The petitioner pleaded that its tender was the lowest quoted one and that in order to favour the previous contractor, who is the

lowest tenderer No.2 in the present tender notice, respondent No.2 has not been finalising the tenders.

At the hearing, Mr.T.K.Raghavan, learned Standing Counsel for the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, representing the respondent, submitted that since a new Vice-Chancellor has taken the charge recently, he will take a decision on the tenders very soon and intimate the result to the petitioner and others.

In the light of this submission of the learned Standing Counsel, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent to complete the tender process and communicate the decision to the petitioner within one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

As a sequel, WPMP.No.38696 of 2012, filed by the petitioner for interim relief, is disposed of as infructuous.
