Ananthasagaram Police Station, registered for the offence under

Section 307 read with 34 of I.P.C.

This is the second anticipatory bail application. The earlier

application being Criminal Petition No.5130 of 2012 filed by the

petitioner came to be dismissed on 27-6-2012.

Heard learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned

Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State.

It is contended by the learned Counsel appearing for the

petitioner that police completed the investigation and therefore the

petitioner deserves for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the

respondent-State opposed the petition.

The earlier application came to be dismissed taking into the

gravity of the offence. Mere completion of investigation does not dilute

the gravity of the offence. In that view of the matter, I do not see any

changed circumstances that enure to the benefit of the petitioner to

renew his request for grant of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, Criminal Petition is dismissed.
