## Surva Kant, J. (Oral)

The petitioner who is working as P.T.I. in the Education Department, Government of Punjab, seeks pay scales equivalent to Hindi/Punjabi Teachers (Language Teachers) on the basis of judgment dated 7.5.2009 of this Court passed in a bunch of writ petitions including CWP No.16380 of 1989 (Balbir Singh and others versus State of Punjab and others).

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties are *ad-idem* that the controversy involved in this case stands settled by the afore-cited decision.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court in <u>Balbir Singh and others' case (supra</u> and the respondents are directed to consider the claim of the petitioner accordingly.

In case the petitioner's claim is found covered under the afore-cited decision, the consequential benefits shall be given notionally. However, if the respondents find that the claim of the petitioner is distinguishable, they shall dispose of it by passing a speaking order within a period of *four months* from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
