Counsel for the respondents has placed on record order dated 27.7.2012 passed by the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Fatehabad vide which the earlier order dated 21.1.2010 regularizing the services of Virender Singh-petitioner No.14 stands withdrawn and, therefore, the basis for claiming the benefit does not sustain.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if the main writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.18401 of 2009 **Mukesh Kumar vs. The State of Haryana and others**, decided on 10.1.2012 (Annexure P-10).

In the light of the above, this writ petition is taken up for final

disposal and is disposed of with directions to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in **Mukesh Kumar's case** (supra), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith. In case the petitioners are held entitled to the claim as made by them, consequential benefits be released to them within a further period of one month.
