Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for the issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent No.4 and 5. The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have allegedly got married. They have already moved a representation dated 26.06.2012 (Annexure P-6) before respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, for protecting their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to take an appropriate action on the representation dated 26.06.2012 (Annexure P-6).

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Senior

Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to take an appropriate action on the representation dated 26.06.2012 (Annexure P-6) taking into consideration the validity of the marriage, as well as, the age of the petitioners and if some substance is found therein, necessary steps, in accordance with law, be taken thereon.
