Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for the issuance of a direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos. 4 to 6. The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have got married. They have already moved a representation dated 24.07.2012 (Annexure P/3) before respondent No.2 - Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, for protecting their life and liberty.

The instant petition is being disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Bathinda , for protection, as per instructions dated 18.08.2010 issued by the Home Department, Punjab. Petitioners may not be arrested and adequate security be provided to them, if required.
