SABINA, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.358 dated 9.10.2012, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Surajkund District Faridabad.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 6.11.2012:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in a civil suit filed by the original owner Harbans Kaur against Aslam Khan, compromise has been effected. Now the original owner or the purchaser have not suffered any loss.

Notice of motion for 30.11.2012.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tribhuwan Narayan, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of the order reproduced above and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the order dated 6.11.2012, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
