Short affidavit on behalf of respondent no.2 has been filed in the Court today. According to which, the petitioner has secured 130 marks. The cut off marks for calling a candidate for interview on the basis of shortlisting has been fixed as 132 marks. Since the petitioner has scored less than 132 marks, she cannot be called for interview in the General Category. As far as, the female category is concerned, again the cut off marks is 132 which also the petitioner does not fulfill. In view of the specific affidavit field by the respondents, the claim of the petitioner does not survive. Counsel for the petitioner disputes this assertion of the respondent.

Liberty is thus granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application with documentary proof in case the affidavit filed by the respondent is to be disputed by the petitioner.
