Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of habeas corpus seeking the release of alleged detenue Daljit Singh son of Parvinder Singh from the illegal captivity of respondents No.4 to 6. The petitioner claims herself to be the wife of the alleged detenue.

In pursuance to the order dated June 28, 2012, Station House Officer, Police Station Nawanshahar – respondent No.3 has come present in Court. He states that he could not appear on the last date as the information was received late. He has identified the alleged detenue Daljit Singh.

Learned counsel for respondents No.5, after seeking

instructions from respondent No.5, states that respondent No.4 has since expired, therefore, today he is appearing for respondent No.5 only.

Daljit Singh – alleged detenue, has also come present in Court. He has stated that he had never been in the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6, rather, he has been residing voluntarily with his parents and brothers.

In view of the statement made by Daljit Singh, no further orders are called for. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.
