Petitioners, who are working as JBT Teachers, were appointed in the year 1999 on regular basis. Promotion of the JBT Teachers to the post of Master was ordered on 12.12.2010 (Annexure P-1) but the claim of the petitioners, despite they being senior, was not considered and decided by the respondents. The cases of the petitioners, which were sent for promotion, were duly received by the office of respondent No.2 but till date, no decision thereon has been taken and the claim of the petitioners is pending for consideration. Since the persons junior to the petitioners stand promoted w.e.f. 12.12.2010, petitioners raised their grouse through a representation dated 30.04.2012 (Annexure P-2). The said representation is still pending without any decision.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage if a direction is issued to the Commissioner-cum-Director General, School Education-Haryana respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 30.04.2012 (Annexure P-2) within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting

thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner-cum-Director General, School Education-Haryana respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 30.04.2012 (Annexure P-2) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

In case, the petitioners are held entitled to the claim made by them through their representation, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to them, in accordance with law, within a further period of two months.
