A property sold by the husband of the petitioner, according to the complainant who purported to have purchased the same, was mortgaged with the bank. It is the allegation that the said property has been sold without discharging the mortgage. It is the contention of the petitioner that she had no role to play with the sale of the said property. It is her contention that she only stood as a guarantor to the loan that was obtained by her husband from the bank. On this First Information Report, investigation is on. The present writ petition challenges this First Information Report.

2. I do not think any case has been made out by the petitioner to interfere with the First Information Report. The writ petition fails and the same is dismissed.
