Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and on going through the contents of the FIR as well as considering the gravity of the facts of the case, the Court is inclined to make the order of arrest stay. It is thus, directed that during the course of investigation, both the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.521 of 2012/N.C.R. No.43/2012 registered at Police Station Kashipur, Distt. U.S. Nagar, under Sections 323, 504, 506, 427 IPC r/w Section 3(1)(x) of SC/ST Act, provided they cooperate with the investigating agency. It is hereby made clear that this order will automatically come to an end as soon as any report, in the form of chargesheet or final report, as the case may be, is filed before the Court concerned.

With the aforesaid directions, the petition is finally disposed of.
