By this writ petition, a challenge is made to the order of suspension.

I find that an appeal lies under rule 22 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1958. In view of aforesaid, writ petition is dismissed in view of availability of alternative remedy. Petitioner would, however, be at liberty to prefer an appeal against the order of suspension and if appeal is preferred, the authority concerned is expected to consider and decide the same expeditiously, if possible, within a period of two months from the date of its filing.
