Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Altogether 12 persons are named as accused of a case which has been registered for offences under Sections 302 and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The written report of Anuj Kumar Singh has resulted into an FIR with regard to killing of informant's brother Rohit Kumar Singh. On the telephonic message of Chhotu Singh and Rahul Singh, informant's brother left the house and he was seen going with the petitioner and others and in the next morning his dead body was found.

Submission is that killing was not seen by any one. The petitioner had not called the informant's brother. There is no overt act against the petitioner.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner has been opposed by learned Addl.P.P. assisted by learned counsel appearing for the informant.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in Bakhtiyarpur P.S.Case No. 65 of 2013.
