From Annexure-2, statement of Vandana Kumari recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C, it is apparent that she had ruled out being kidnapped rather she had spoken that she had gone to her maternal uncle's place.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner Suject Kumar is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in Vaishali, Sarai P.S.Case No.116 of 2013, G.R.No.2978 of 2013.
