Heard counsel for the parties.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail in a case instituted under diverse sections of the Arms Act in connection with Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No.180 of 2012.

As per the allegation, the petitioner along with one person riding on a motorcycle was intercepted by the informant. One pistol and five live cartridges are said to have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and his accomplice namely Ashique Ansari. Huge cache of ammunitions are said to have been recovered from the dickey of the motorcycle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that another co-accused of this case namely Aashik Ansari has been released on bail by order dated 25.06.2013 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 14940 of 2013. Explaining his antecedents it is stated that the petitioner was required in one more case in which he has already been acquitted by the learned trial court. The petitioner is said to be

languishing in jail since 02.11.2012.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner abovenamed is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger in Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No. 180/12 subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be his own/close family member.
