Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. J.N. Thakur, learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420,467,468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the petitioner being the Ward Member issued divorce certificate in favour of Kumari Rubi and on the basis of same, she got selected on the post of Sevika.

It is submitted that the said certificate was subsequently been cancelled. A statement has been made in paragraph no. 11 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Rajauli P.S. Case No. 181

of 2012 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Nawada, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
