Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code and 138 of N.I. Act, is named accused in this case with allegation of issuance of cheques against the loans which have been bounced.

Submission is of false implication and betrayal by the informant in spite of receiving the amount in cash for which the cheques were issued in fact as a guarantee. Further, the petitioner is in custody for about six months **having no criminal antecedent**.

If it is so, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Daudnagar, Aurangabad, in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No. 141 of 2012, subject to condition to remain physically present before the court below on each and every date till disposal of the case and in case of failure on two consecutive dates without giving any reasonable explanation, the privilege granted shall be deemed to be cancelled.
