Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Having regard to the nature of allegation that the petitioner has been confronted under Section 395/412 of the Indian Penal Code wherein the mobile of the informant has not only been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner but also having been put on Test Identification Parade has been identified by the informant, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, namely, Anish Kumar for the present.

The petitioner in fact is in custody since 23.6.2012 and, therefore, if his trial is not taken up and concluded by June, 2014, he will have the liberty initially to move before the trial court which will then go into the reason for not taking up and concluding the trial, whereafter, the petitioner can move for bail to this Court.
