2. This petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner who apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged under Section 306/34 of the I.P.C.

3. The allegation is with regard to eleven persons named in the First Information Report are responsible for the death of the informant's brother.

4. It is submitted that other than naming the petitioner who happened to be the Nana-Sasur of the deceased there is no whisper of any specific allegation against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner's case stand on a better footing than the Mausea-Sasur of the deceased Sanjay Kumar, who has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 11988 of 2013.

5. Considering the above facts, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within 6 weeks

from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna, in connection with Patrakar Nagar P.S. Case No. 223/2012, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
