
Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120B, 363 and 366A of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of kidnapping the daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in 164 Cr. P.C. statement, the victim has stated that she was taken away by Ravindra Ram and married with him in temple when Ravindra Ram establish physical relationship. The petitioners are the father and brothers of Ravindra Ram.

Considering the fact that in 164 Cr. P.C. statement, the victim has not named the petitioners, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12



weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Mahua P.S. Case No. 341 of 2012, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
