Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This criminal revision is directed against the order dated
27.11.2009 passed in Miscellaneous Case No. 78 of 2001 by the court
of Principal Judge, Family Court, Gopalganj, whereby the learned
Principal Judge, Family Court directed the petitioner to pay Rs. 1500/-
per month to his wife/opposite party no. 2, Urmila Devi, by way of
maintenance since the date of filing of the case i.e. 18.04.2000.

On perusal of the impugned order, apparently, I find no
illegality. Accordingly, this criminal revision stands dismissed.
