Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under sections 447,341,323,324 and 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged that in the background of dispute with regard to irrigation, the petitioner caused fire arm injury on the hand of the informant.

It is submitted that the injury has been found to be simple and from the injury itself, it appears that there was no intention to kill.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner constitutes good grounds for consideration of regular bail of the petitioner by the learned court below considering that the petitioner is a retired military personnel in case the petitioner surrenders within six weeks from today in connection with Sikrol
