ORAL ORDER

2 24-12-2013 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 498 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner No. 1 is the father-in-law whereas petitioner
No. 2 is the mother-in-law of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the husband
of the complainant died on 22.07.2013 after filing of the complaint
case. He further submits that the allegation of demand of dowry
and torture are general. It has been stated in paragraph No. 9 of
the application that the complainant herself has married another
person after death of her husband.



In view of the above, let the above named petitioner, in the event of their arrest / surrender within six weeks from today before the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount, each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad, in connection with Complaint Case No. 432/2012, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
