When the matter is called out, none appears for the petitioner. It appears from the record that on 01.04.2013 a prayer for time was made on behalf of the petitioner for obtaining instructions and the said prayer was allowed. Again on 09.04.2013, learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for a day's accommodation and the said prayer was also allowed. Today neither the learned counsel for the petitioner appeared nor any prayer for adjournment is made. Ms AS Lodh, learned Addl. GA for the State respondents is present. In view of the above, there is no other alternative before this Court except to dismiss the matter for default as the instant writ petition is pending since 2005. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is dismissed for default. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
