The instant application is filed by the appellant-petitioners under Order 41 Rule 14 read with Order 5 Rule 20(1-A) of the Code of Civil Procedure for service of notices upon the respondents No. 6, 7 and 8 of the connected RSA No. 61 of 2012 by way of substitute service through newspaper. Heard Mr. D Chakraborty, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. H Laskar, learned counsel for the appellant-petitioners as well as Ms P Chakraborty, learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 2, 4, 9, 10 and 11 who has no objection to the prayer for substitute service, as sought for. Considering the entire facts and circumstances and for the reasons stated in the petition, the prayer for substitute service is allowed. Appellant-petitioners are directed to take steps by way of substitute service through publication in two well circulated newspapers in Tripura within three weeks and after publication of the notice the newspapers be also furnished before this Court.
