Heard Mr. BK Mahajan, learned counsel, appearing for the petitioner and Mr. H. S. Sarma, learned Addl. PP, Assam, appearing for the State respondent.

Perused the case dairy.

By this application, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner, namely, Shri Bimal Sarma has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Mangaldoi P.S. Case No. 278/2013, under Sections 468/ 471/ 420/ 34 IPC.

The matter relates to illegality committed in allotment of works to the contractor.

From the record, it appears that the petitioner had issued experience certificate in favour of the concerned contractor. The petitioner, who is on interim bail, has already been examined by the I.O.

Having heard the learned counsel for both the parties and considering the evidence so far collected by the I.O., I find no necessity for custodial interrogation of the petitioner. Accordingly, interim order, dated 22.05.2013 is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the I.O., within seven days from this date and on such other dates, as may be required for the purpose of investigation.
