Perused the case diary.

By this application, filed under Section 438 CrPC the petitioners namely, ((1) O kil Ray (2) Surendra Ray and (3) Ramesh Ray has prayed for pre-arrest bail, in connection with Bhangagarh P.S. Case No.118 of 2013 (Corresponding to GR Case No. 6913 of 2013) under Section 109/294/339/350/387/403/415/506/511/34 IPC.

The allegation made against the petitioners are that the petitioner No.1 had taken a loan of Rs.1,00,000/- from the informant with promise to return the same but he failed to do so. It has also been stated that the petitioners again asked for money from the informant and due to refusal on the part of the informant, the petitioners had threatened to assault him.

Having heard the learned counsel of both the parties and considering the materials on record, I find no necessity for custodial interrogation of the petitioners in connection with this case.

Accordingly, the interim order passed by this Court on 27.6.2013 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear before the I.O. within 7 days and on such other days as and when required.
