By this application, filed under Section 438 CrPC the petitioner namely, Mohammad Ali Chowdhury has prayed for pre-arrest bail, in connection with Dhubri P.S. Case No.615 of 2012 under Section 406/409/468/34 IPC.

The matter relates to the fraudulent withdrawal of money from the account of the Job Card Holders by using false Job Card.

Having heard the learned counsel of both the parties and considering the evidence so far collected by the Investigating Officer as well as the nature of the alleged offence, I do not find it to be a fit case to extend the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

Hence, the prayer for pre-arrest bail submitted on behalf of the petitioner stands rejected.
