

The 7 petitioners are venture Schools within Mayong Jagiroad and Mikirbhita P.S. of Morigaon District. The schools were established on 01.01.1990, 01.01.1989, 01.01.1987, 01.01.1992, 20.11.1994, 01.01.,1983 and 03.01.1990 respectively. They seek direction for providing the District Information on School Education (DISE) code to the schools for the year 2009-10, as the same is made compulsory under the notification dated 21.06.2012. to enable the schools to receive the benefits due to venture schools in the State.

2. Mr. G. Goswami, Standing Counsel, SSA, Mr. A. Deka, Standing Counsel, Education and Mr. A. Choudhury, Govt. Advocate however submit that DISE code is nothing but a numerical representation to confirm the identity of a functioning school and the DISE code itself is not enough for any school, to be considered for either provincialisation or other government benefits.

3. However, the respondents refer to the recent notification dated 30.01.2013 to project that Grievance Redressal Committee have been constituted in the District and State Level and the grievances of petitioners' school can be directed to be considered by the concerned committee. Mr. B. Rahman, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners is also in favour of disposal of the petitioners' grievance by a redressal committee.

4. In view of above consensus, the petitioners are permitted to give individual representation(s), copies of this order and the writ petition within 2(two) weeks to the District Level Redressal Committee constituted under govt. notification dated 30.01.2013. The representation should then be considered on merit expeditiously and preferably within 2(two) months, from the date of receipt of communication from the petitioners.

5. With the aforesaid direction, the case is disposed of.
