

Heard Mr. M.K. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. J. Abed in, learned Standing Counsel, Education Department.

The matter relates to the prayer of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground. The prayer so made is on account of death of her husband who died in harness on 16/02/2012. He was serving as Grade-IV employee in the Barna rddi High School, in the district of Nalbari, Assam.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the guidelines formulated in Achyut Ranjan Das Vs. State of Assam & Ors. reported in (2006) 4 GLT 674 and Foziron Nessa Vs. State of Assam & Ors. reported in (2010) 4 GLT 340 will govern this case.

Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of providing that the respondents may examine the case of the petitioner in terms of the guidelines formulated in Achyut Ranjan Das (supra) and Foziron Nessa (supra). Needless to say that the petitioner shall not be considered in isolation and the consideration shall confine only to one member of the family, i.e. to say the petitioner, and no other family members and the consideration will be strictly as per the parameters and yardsticks laid down in the guidelines.

Writ petition is disposed of.
