By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for a direction to the respondents to clear the outstanding bills pertaining to some contractual works he has allegedly undertaken under the respondents.

In Tamser Ali Vs. State of Assam reported in (2008) 4 GLT 1, this Court in similar matters has issued certain guidelines towards processing such bills. It is submitted that this case is squarely covered by the said judgment.

In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to examine the case of the petitioner in terms of the said judgment.

The petitioner may obtain a certified copy of this order and produce the same before the respondent authority along with a copy of the writ petition and its enclosures for their needful action in terms of this order.

The writ petition is disposed of.
